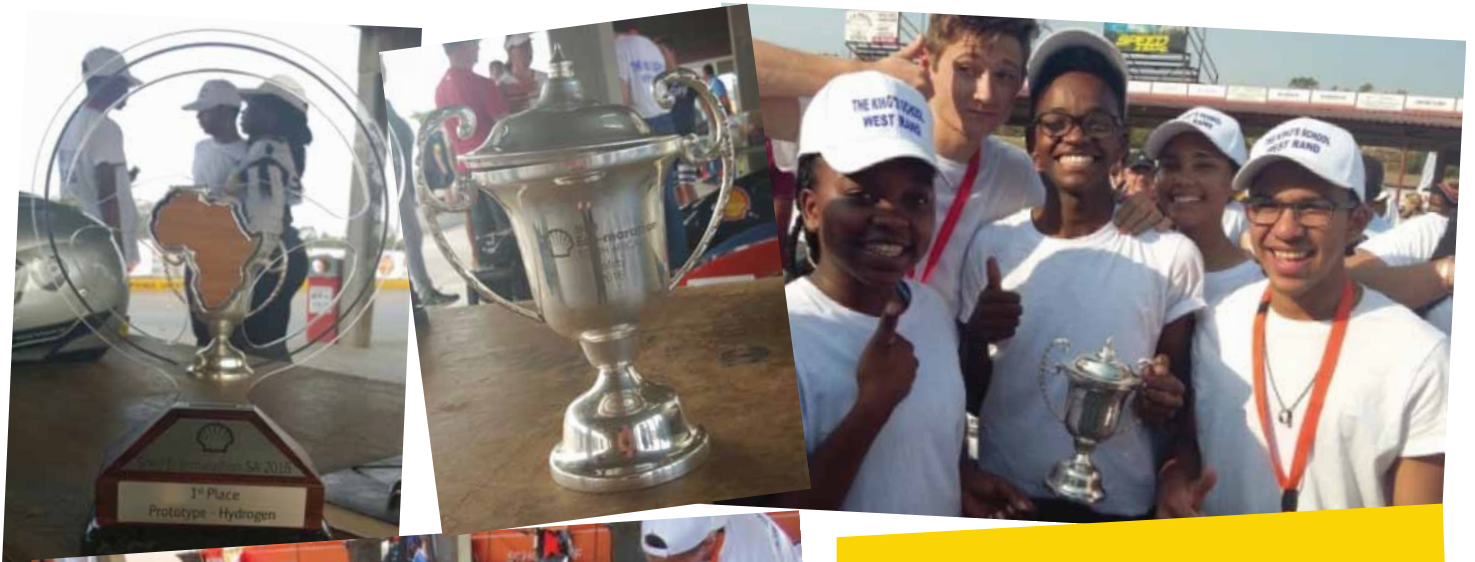
We are extremely proud of our Science Club learners. They competed in the Shell Eco Marathon last weekend.

The H<sub>2</sub> (hydro) car reached a distance of 280 km per litre and the battery car reached 206 km per litre.

H<sub>2</sub> (Hydrogen) car came 1st with 327km/kWh and the Battery Car came 3rd overall with 222km/kWh. Our team came 1st for Safety.

**Project Connect** posted on Facebook: “I’m not sure that everyone understands what these kids achieved. On their first attempt at a Shell Eco Marathon even with a Hydrogen propelled vehicle, they achieved a result of 327km/m<sup>3</sup> of Hydrogen. The
