WAITING CLASS RULES AND PROCEDURES



Grade RR and Grade R: Will be in teacher supervised waiting area (sandpit area) from 13:00 to 13:30 where after they will go to Aftercare and will be entered into the Aftercare at 14:20.

Grade 1 to Grade 3: Will be in Teacher supervised waiting class from 13:00 to 13:30. Children will then go to supervised waiting class under the shade netting from 13:30 until 14:15.

Grade 4 to Grade 6: Will be in a supervised waiting area under the shade netting until 14:15.

All children from Grade 1 to Grade 6 will go to the waiting area, and then Aftercare from 14:15.

No child is allowed to wait down on the field or in the car park for their transport.

Every child needs to be fetched personally – no hooting for children. This rule is to be strictly enforced. Please inform your transport company of this rule.



STARTING TIMES AND ENDING TIMES

Starting time: For all students is 07:30. Parents, please ensure that children are dropped off punctually. A pattern of tardiness with respect to time is a precursor to failure in many other disciplines.

Ending times: Pre-school, Grade 1 + 2 = 13:00
 Grade 3 – Grade 7 = 13:30
 Grade 8 – Grade 12 = 14:00
