They pointed out that they had an advantage over many of the other students because The King's School had taught them, not just how to get good marks, but how to **THINK**, how to **PROBLEM SOLVE**, how to **EVALUATE CRITICALLY**. And how to **WORK HARD**.

I'm always delighted when I get feedback like this and am very grateful for our team of teachers. But even the best teachers sometimes fall into the trap of just teaching content and presenting information. And even the best students sometimes fall into the trap of just memorising facts and receiving information passively.

When Paul speaks to the young Timothy, he urges him to study and to 'rightly divide the word of truth'. He's telling him not to simply receive information passively, but to handle it,

to ask questions of it. We try and teach our students to do likewise. To receive information and ask questions like, "what can I do with this information?", "how can I bring the Gospel message to bear on this world I'm learning about?", "what is the solution to the problem being presented?", "what does this information tell me about the nature of people and God?", "how does Scripture, which gives me all I need for life and godliness, propose a better way forward?"

Let us as adults engage with our kids, using carefully chosen questions to help them rightly *divide the word of truth* that is delivered from their teacher or textbook.
