

UPDATE ON SWIMMING POOL PROJECT AT THE KING'S SCHOOL

We would like to provide our parents with an update on the progress made on the swimming pool construction project as it currently stands:

1.Mr. Kobus Coetsee of Inventas Projects has been appointed as the project manger to oversee the process.

2.Mr. Howard Johnston of Johnston Architects has drawn up the site plan, including main pool, learn-to-swim pool, pump room and surrounds.

3.Mr. Herman van der Mast of BD Pool Services has been appointed to prepare the tender specifications and oversee the tender process.

4.C-Plan Structural Engineers have been appointed to deal with the scope of work regarding the engineering specifications.

5.Water Dimension International have been appointed to deal with the hydraulic design of the swimming pool's filtration and chemical treatment systems. We apologize that it seems to have taken so much time to start with actual construction, but it has been important to finalize many consultations with professionals, planning meetings regarding swimming pool specs and the tender documentation.

Our project manager has estimated that construction will begin in February 2018.


Mouthful Café will manage the tuck shop at The King's School West Rand as from January 2018.
