Becoming

BAPTIZED

in Christ



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One of the great ordinances or sacraments of our Christian faith is baptism. Most people think of the ceremony where believers are submerged under water, and then lifted out as they are baptized in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. But what they are thinking of is the symbol of baptism, and not the full scope of baptism.

John Piper says that just as when you get married, you say "with this ring I thee wed", we should remember the ring is but a symbol of something much more - a marriage. He says we could similarly say "with this baptism I become united with Christ".

The word baptise appears 67 times in the New Testament. Two different Greek words are used - bapto and baptizo. Both words are translated 'to dip, immerse or plunge' but the one has a much fuller meaning.

Bapto is used only 3 times; once when the rich man asks from hell that Lazarus be allowed to bapto his finger in water and place it on his tongue, another when Jesus reveals his betrayer by the bapto of a morsel which is given to Judas, and lastly in Revelation when Jesus is described as wearing a gown that is bapto in blood.

Each case depicts a dipping or immersion. Baptizo, which is used on all the other occasions, also means to dip or immerse, but the meaning is greatly expanded.

Nicander, an Ancient Greek wrote a section on making pickles where he explains the difference.

Nicander says that in order to make a pickle, the vegetable should first be 'dipped'(bapto) into boiling water and then 'baptised' (baptizo) in the vinegar solution.

Both verbs concern the immersing of vegetables in a solution. But the first is temporary. The second, the act of baptising (baptizo) the vegetable, happens over an extended period and produces a permanent change. When used in the New Testament, this word refers to our union and identification with Christ symbolised by our water baptism.

Jesus says in Mark 16:16,
'He that believes and is baptised shall be saved'.

Christ is saying that mere intellectual assent is not enough. There must be a union with him, a real change, like the vegetable to the pickle!

May our students be 'pickled' in a solution of Christian community at The King's School and become permanently changed by The Holy Spirit.
