From the comfortable vantage point of our beautiful school, it is hard to believe some frightening statistics that have been released recently concerning education in our country. Far fewer teachers have been given posts than were needed, resulting in up to 50 students per class in state schools; 33 000 pupils were not allocated schools this year; Equal Education estimates the real matric pass rate to be below 40% (and not the 75% that the department is celebrating); our international Maths and English rankings are extremely low and there are still about 500 mud hut schools still in our county.

As we enjoy and appreciate all that God has given us in the school, we, as a board of directors, have felt for a few years now that God is calling us to go beyond the borders of our school and make a difference in the education crisis in our country.

We are very excited about building our new nursery and preschool on the property next door as well as building our swimming pool as soon as municipal approval comes through. This has been a frustratingly slow process but we continue to trust God for His perfect timing. Please pray with us that God will remove all obstacles so that these projects can start as soon as possible.

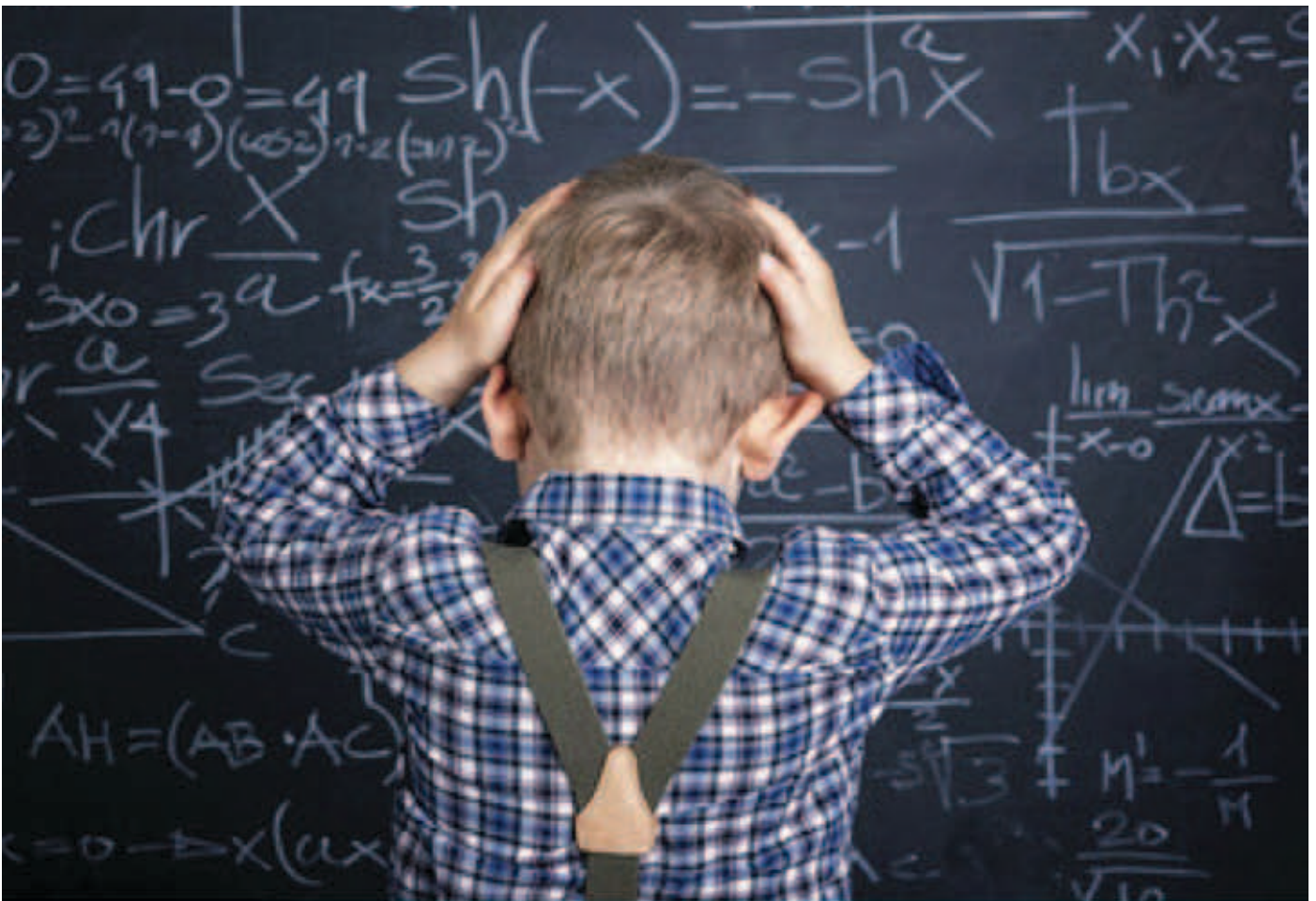
