John started at The King's School West Rand in 2000 and has been an integral part of the growth and success of the school ever since. As a Deputy Principal and part of the executive team for the last few years, he provided leadership in many different areas, including sports, finances and operations. But perhaps his most incisive leadership moments were in speaking into the unique calling of the school -distinctive Christian education aimed at raising a generation who would follow Christ and serve his mission in the world within the different sectors of society. John knew the Scriptures and spent

time searching God's Word and studying it, meditating on it and making it practical for life. He often spoke to his students about "Accounting with God" and "Accounting without God" - what does that look like, and how will we choose to use what we learn? He produced outstanding Matric results, and was committed to pour hours of extra effort into giving his Accounting students the best preparation for their final exams. On the sports front, John has laid the foundation for the excellent results we are generating across a number of sporting codes, and has built a department that operates with slick efficiency in terms of fixtures, facilities, accolades, and coaching.

John-Mark, you are a hero of The King's School West Rand. We will cherish the memories you have created here. The deposit that you have invested into countless past students has been like gold, often pointing kids to Jesus. We'll meet you on the streets of gold, Mr. T!

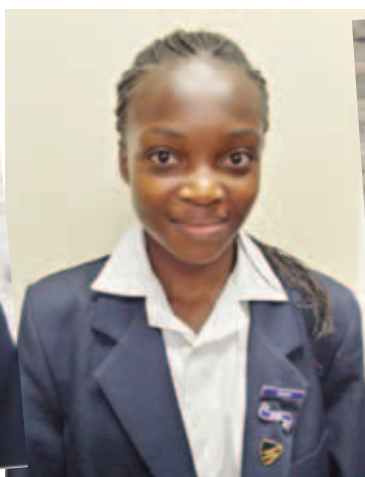
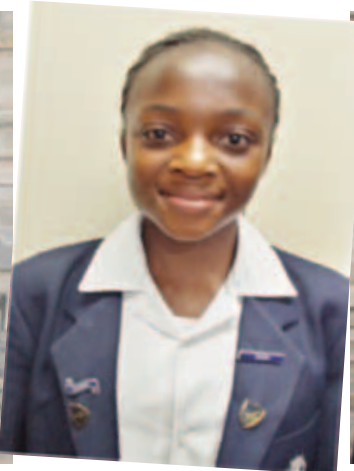
