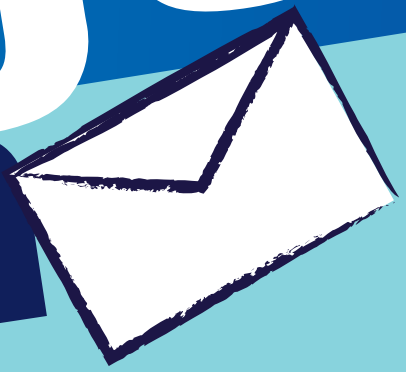

"And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit" (Ephesians 2:22).

Lastly, parents, steward this precious possession of children well. What you value they will value. Let them see your commitment to the church, even when, and especially when, it's a commitment in spite of setbacks.

Please don't give up on the church.

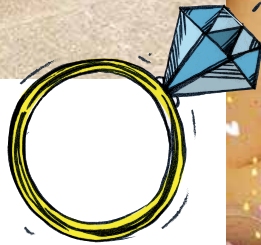

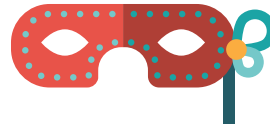
