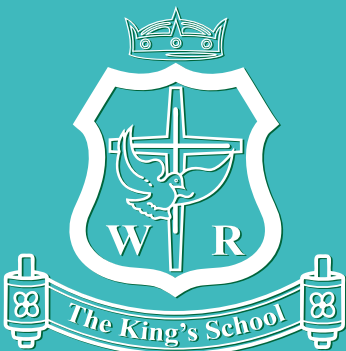

- Molemo Pii 1 gold, 2 silver and 3 bronze.

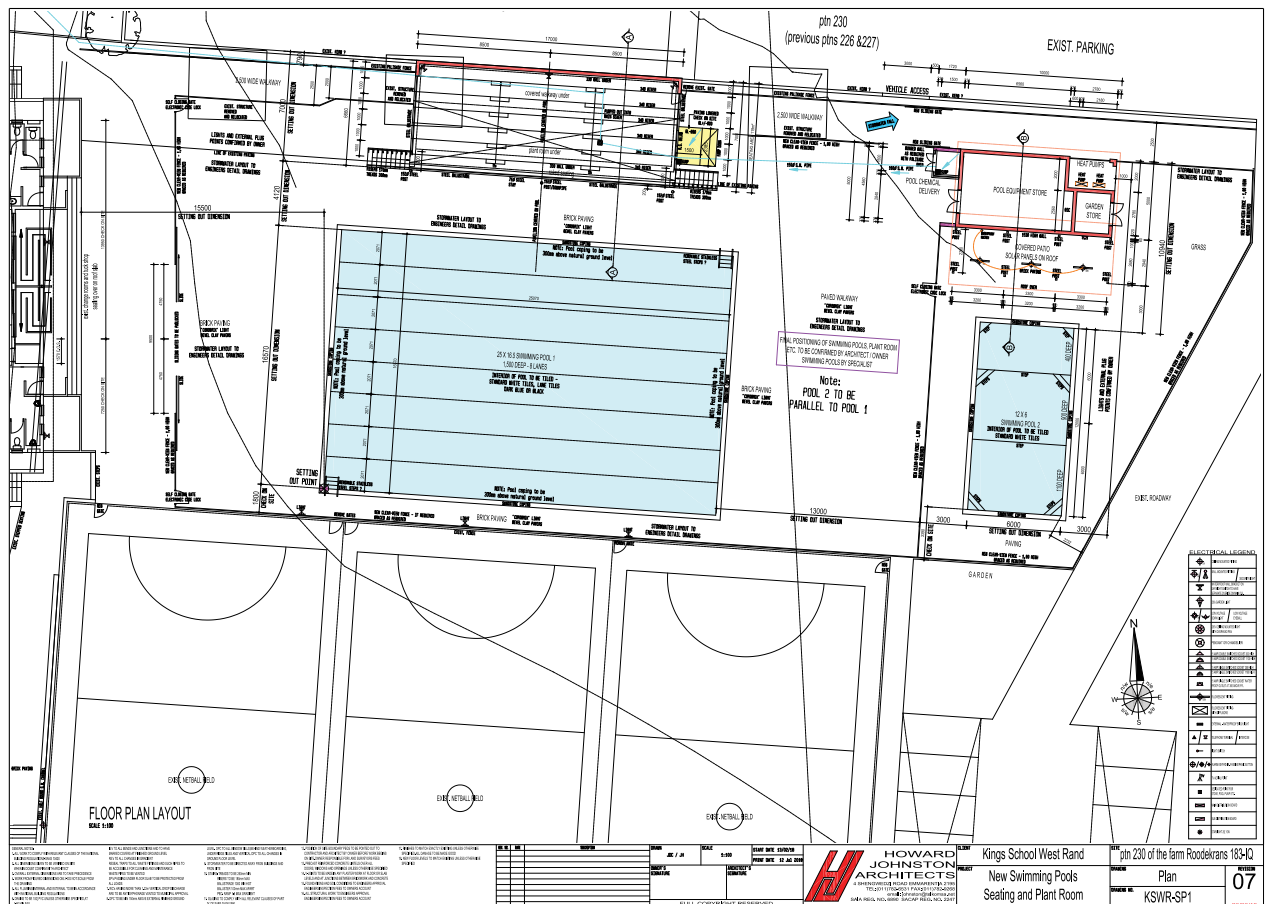
