
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In a world where robots are being designed to do much of the work, what must our kids be mastering at school to ensure that they will emerge as highly employable graduates? I would like us to encourage our youngsters to be developing skills of metacognition rather than just skills of cognition. Here's a simple graphic that describes what is meant by metacognition (See Below).

Both in class time and when students are studying, they need to be encouraged to really grapple with concepts, turn them inside out, look at them from

different angles, consider how they may be applied, use information for problem solving, make inferences and deductions, examine feelings, passions, desires in the area of study, and consider how redemptive solutions can be found in areas of brokenness.

When students can practice and eventually master such skills, they will be able to call to action these skills in multiple different settings and vocations. Please encourage your child to be asking questions like this to maximise their learning.


