Last but not least - thank you to all of our learners for your dedication and passion for the activities that you were involved in. We look forward to a busy and enjoyable 2019!



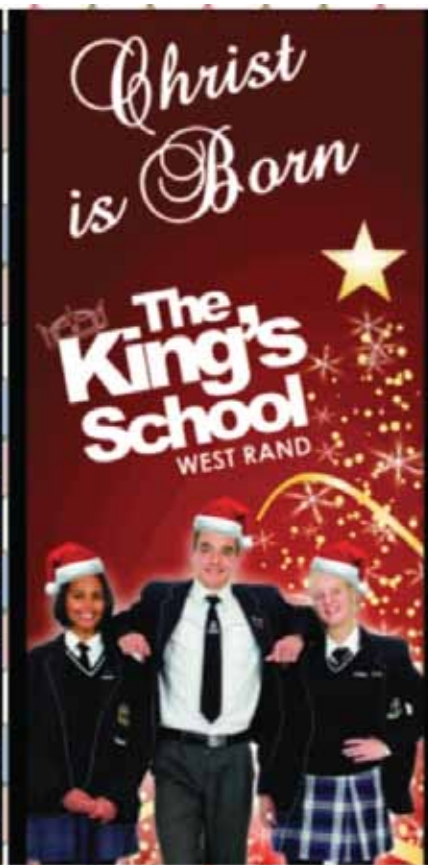
