## DEVELOPING EQ IN YOUR CHILD

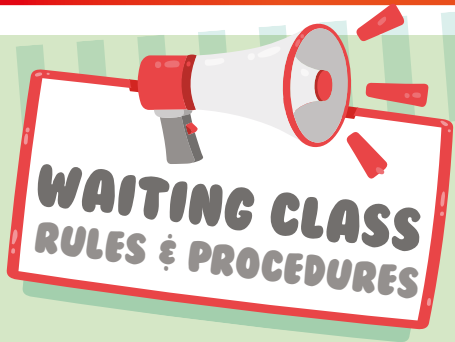
