GRADE RR & GRADE R:

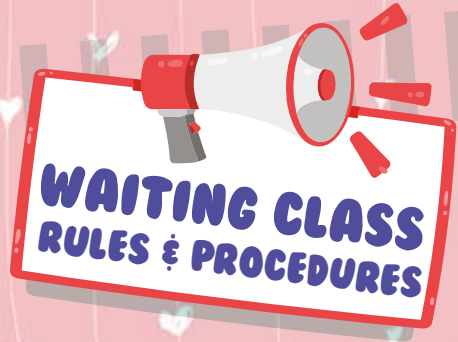
