FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

School represents a phase in a person's life which is preparatory. Preparation for adulthood, parenthood and work life. But often our worldview prevents us from granting this preparatory time. We want to measure our kids by their achievements, as though they are already the finished product, and not an incomplete, developing human being.

We often want to jump in and remove 'obstacles' that might distract them from their 'studies', but fail to see that these are in fact not hindrances, but powerful learning opportunities. And when we continue in this manner, our young students are increasingly unable to resolve the challenges they face, or unable to develop the resilience to work through or persevere through hardship.

The learning that your child will receive at The King's School is not limited to a textbook or a curriculum, in fact, these are minor parts of their learning. Problem-solving, socialising, seeking help, creativity and executive function are not scheduled in periods or listed in a syllabus, but they are

learnt by doing life in the school community. Our school has a covenant relationship with parents to raise children who are strong in their faith and who are able to navigate life's challenges with peace and confidence. Parents should never feel that they need to 'rescue' their child from problems they may experience, whether it is a relationship breakdown with their friends or with a teacher, a problem grasping a lesson topic, a test meltdown or any other tribulation they may face. Rather we should guide them to be problem solvers, peace-makers and relationship builders who take ownership of their predicament and fix it themselves.

And if they struggle initially, no problem! School is preparatory. No-one is expected to ace it on the first try. But every try means they've learnt something new.

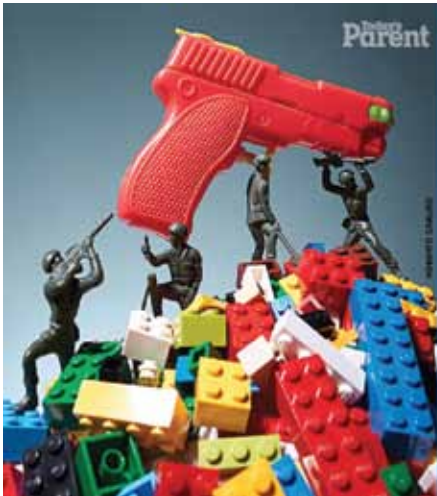
