

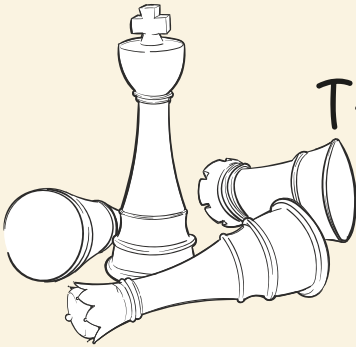
The Primary School fixtures in the West Rand have begun. The results against Gustav Preller Primary (25 April) are as follows:
