Author Anne Rice, after 10 years as a Christian wrote this,

"For those who care, and I understand if you don't: Today I quit being a Christian. I'm out. I remain committed to Christ as always but not to being 'Christian' or to being part of Christianity. It's simply impossible for me to 'belong' to this quarrelsome, hostile, disputatious, and deservedly infamous group. For ten years, I've tried. I've failed. I'm an outsider. My conscience will allow nothing else."

Ouch, this really stings! It makes me self-examine with regards to my own witness and that of the Christian communities I belong to - my church, our school and even my family. I pray that God would help us to be a sweet fragrance, that we would be known by the love we have for one another (even in the parking lot!).

We won't always get it right, but as we confront the wrong attitudes that reside within us and return to God in repentance, I trust that our abiding testimony would be one of unity and peace and kindness. May

the grace and mercy that Christ has given us be the grace and mercy we afford to others.

At The King's School, we have a Grievance Resolution Policy that operates on the Matthew 18 principle. "If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over." The 'just between the two of you' principle takes courage and is always aimed at reconciliation and understanding so that we may 'bear one another's burdens in love'.

Please forgive me for the times that I have personally got this wrong. Those times have hurt me, have hurt the other party and have damaged the testimony demonstrated to unbelievers. It's not okay. The way of the Kingdom of God is so much better and I know that when I apply it, it reduces the possibility of offense which eventually results in bitterness.

May the Lord help us to reflect him always.
