In an article by Forbes.com in February this year, they share the number one soft skill that employers are seeking. Can you guess what it is?

In their trends study, employers are reporting that success in the workplace requires the skill of creativity. Not the type of creativity we might limit to painting a picture or writing poetry, but creativity that is defined as "the ability to perceive the world in new ways, to find hidden patterns, to make connections between seemingly disparate things, and to generate innovative solutions".

At The King's School we are expecting our teachers to plan their lessons to help cultivate creativity of this kind. After all, as Christians we know that God created the world and made us to be his image bearers. That means that we have the spirit of creativity in us, the Holy Spirit. We do not create like God who creates 'ex nihilo' (creating out of nothing), but we create out of the raw materials that God has created. Sometimes this creative action will be stewardship, taking the wonderful gifts that God has put in place in the world and making them even more productive. At other times it will be working with the things that sin has corrupted and restoring them to God's original design. All in the power and discernment of God's Holy Spirit.
