I wish to thank everyone for being so gracious to our visitors and for extending kindness and hospitality to them. I hope that they will always have good memories of their time with us.

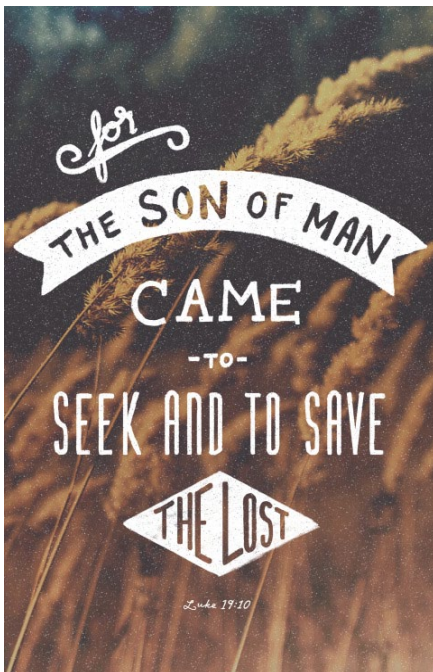
