From the Principal's desk

At the time of writing, there are 3 confirmed cases of Coronavirus infection in South Africa. The King's School West Rand is being proactive in terms of readiness training for teachers, regular communication to parents and precautionary measures on campus. **Please be on the lookout on the school's Awsum app for important information to you as parents, so that we can be coordinating our efforts at this time (there are 3 newsletters already posted).**

I would like to take this opportunity to appeal to our parents to really season our conversation with our children with much wisdom and judgement. Unfortunately our media can sometimes be guilty of fear-mongering and sensationalism and this can create such uncertainty and dread for our children. We need not minimise that this is a seriously dangerous virus that can make us
