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From the Principal's desk



When comparing academic performance across the world, it is consistently found that Asian students (China, South Korea and Japan) have substantially outperformed their Western counterparts at Mathematics. People generally assumed that Asian students had a higher IQ than other cultures, but James Flynn, one of the world's leading experts on IQ, says that Asian IQ's have historically been slightly **lower** than their western counterparts and their achievements have not been because of IQ, but in spite of it (*Asian Americans: Achievement Beyond IQ*, 1991).

In his book *Outliers - The Story of Success*, Malcolm Gladwell argues that the real reason for this statistical observation is that the Asian people have developed a culture over centuries of working incredibly hard, and persevering in the midst of adversity. "Working really hard is what successful people do," says Gladwell, "and the genius of the culture formed in the rice paddies is that hard work gave those in the fields a way to find meaning in the midst of great uncertainty and poverty."

Many Chinese proverbs speak to this culture of hard work. Sayings like,

**"NO FOOD WITHOUT BLOOD AND SWEAT",
"IN WINTER, THE LAZY MAN FREEZES TO DEATH",
"IF A MAN WORKS HARD, THE LAND WILL NOT BE
LAZY".**

Over this last December, I read the book *Outliers*, and the fact that hard work is essential to success resonates with my own experience in leading a school. I have often seen that it is not necessarily the smartest students that remain successful over the long run, but rather it is those who are prepared to put in consistent effort who are the ones who are rewarded.

Let's teach our children that hard-fought gains won by diligence and perseverance are the foundations for future success.

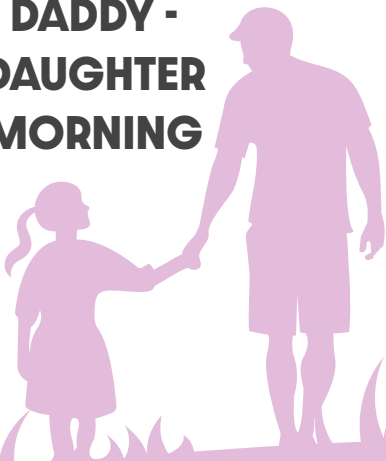
