## Emergency Relief

The recent floods in KZN have wreaked devastation on entire communities with hundreds of lives being lost, homes being swept away or buried under mudslides and road infrastructure being severely damaged.

Survivors that managed to escape have lost family members and all their possessions. In one particularly tragic incident, an individual lost 20 family members. Many of the people remaining in some of the areas have no access to clean water, and much of the relief has been in the form of bottled water. Clothing and blankets are also a desperate need.

As a school, we are contributing to the emergency relief drive in terms of a donation of funds, and we invite parents who are in a position to contribute to please consider making a payment to supplement the school's donation (please reference your payment KZN Relief).

We believe that it is at times like this that the church demonstrates the love of Christ by its rapid response and being the hands and feet of Jesus to a hurting world.
