THE E Learning E xperience

As parents, we send our children to school to learn and they grow in knowledge and fill many books with the information they gain. But often the most important things they learn are not factual knowledge but rather the more incidental learnings embedded within the daily programme.

Learning experiences are things like remaining focused and alert, working collaboratively with fellow students, respecting time by arriving early for school or for a lesson, developing grit and resilience by struggling until they master concepts, and executive functioning skills like being organised and prioritising.

These learning experiences are all critical for eventually being successful in adult life. But sometimes, as parents, we fail to see them as learning experiences but rather we view them as obstacles to be moved aside by parent intervention. When we don't hold our children accountable, or make excuses for them, or do for them what they can do for themselves, we rob our children of the opportunity to grow and learn.

I'm sure that all our children (and our teachers too!) will be lamenting being back at school in the cold early mornings, but we have all rested well and now is the time to get back into training. Train up a child in the way he should go, teaching him to seek God's wisdom and will for his abilities and talents, even when he is old he will not depart from it. (Proverbs 22:6 AMP)

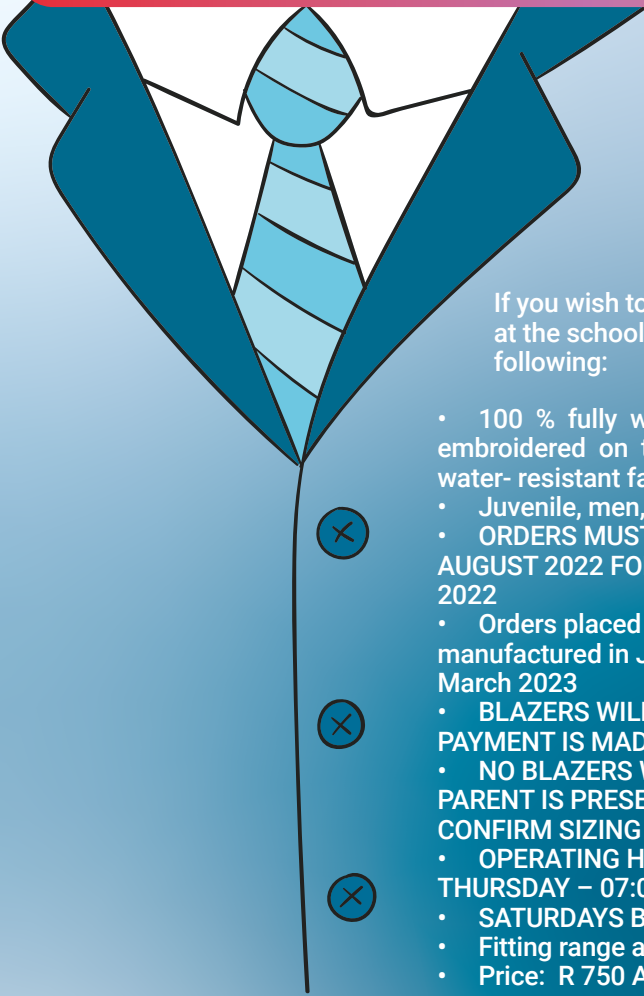
