Teaching our children How To PRAY

From the **PRINCIPAL'S DESK**

Welcome back to term 2 after our Easter break. You will see that we are welcoming some new staff, we've had some new families join us and we've had some internal promotions. We are grateful that we serve a God of seasons.

The 2nd term is always a very busy term for a school. The winter sports are in full swing, learners have adapted to their new grades, revision of the previous year has been covered and a good amount of new teaching has taken place. The tempo is slightly increased and we use the end-of-term examinations to assess whether proper learning has taken place during the first two terms and use this to guide our teaching for term 3. Our grade 4 to 11 learners all write formal exams and the Matrics write assessments in preparation for the prelims & finals that are steadily coming closer.

The 2nd quarter is also a busy season for many businesses and the pace of life has, in my experience, been very busy from April to July for most. As a country, we are also entering a busy period of additional information flowing to us from many sources in preparation for the upcoming elections.

And it is in this increase of pace that a real danger lies. We often tend to neglect important things because of "always being busy". Rest is one of them. Physical activity is another. Family time, and sadly many spiritual disciplines, also get neglected – because we are so busy. But it is especially during this time that we need to draw closer to God and teach our kids to do the same.

It is in times of additional pressure, and additional demands, that we need our Lord the most.

As we continue our Scripture Memory Programme focussed on prayer into the 2nd term, could I invite you to partner with us in prayer? We must teach our children to pray the following Scriptures: For our country and the upcoming elections, God's instruction to the Babylonian exiles in Jeremiah 29:7 to pray for the city they find themselves in ("...pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper" - NIV) is a great start, especially when the narrative is mostly a negative one about what the future holds for our country. 1 Tim 2:1-4 is another powerful Scripture about our approach as Christians to our country.

"I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people— for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth."

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For the academic pressure, the following scriptures are some favourites of mine:

James 1:5; Colossians 3:23-24; Proverbs 14:23; 1 Peter 5:7; Hebrews 12:11. A verse I want to encourage our kids to memorize in preparation for the exam is Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV) "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

May this term, in all the busyness and added pressure, not be a time of stress, but a time of victory through prayer. God bless
