



I often have conversations with Christian parents who are looking for a "real" Christ-centred school for their children. They have noticed that there are schools that call themselves Christian but their educational practices differ very little from secular or public schools.

The educational approach of these schools is to train students in a consumerist mindset - that people are essentially consumers who should maximize their earning potential so they can consume as many entertaining experiences and products as possible. (Jeffrey Bilbro, Christianity Today, May 2024)

At The King's School we believe that such an approach is entirely unbiblical and defies Christian norms that we wish to develop in our students. We prefer to shape our school's educational experience as a formational journey. A formational educational approach doesn't imagine students as consumers who need to get a marketable degree leading to a high-paying job. It sees them as image-bearers of God that, by the grace of Christ, can be shaped through disciplined, focused effort.

Jesus doesn't call people simply to believe in him, he calls them to follow him. In fact, to deny themselves, pick up their cross and follow him (Matthew 16:24). Following Jesus is walking in his ways (demonstrated in the Scriptures) and practising what he taught until we become more like him. It is a formational journey, it won't happen overnight but through the consistent, deliberate and intentional effort of the one who loves Jesus and seeks to follow him as his Lord.

We realize that such a formational experience is best achieved for our children when it is a project that is mirrored at school and at home and in their local church. It is a blessing to the Christian school when parents join hands with their children's teachers to raise adults that seek God's righteousness and his Kingdom first, and then find that all other things are added as well (Matthew 6:33).

Thank you for choosing our school, for choosing Christian Education, and for partnering with us to achieve Excellence in Education to the Glory of God.
