

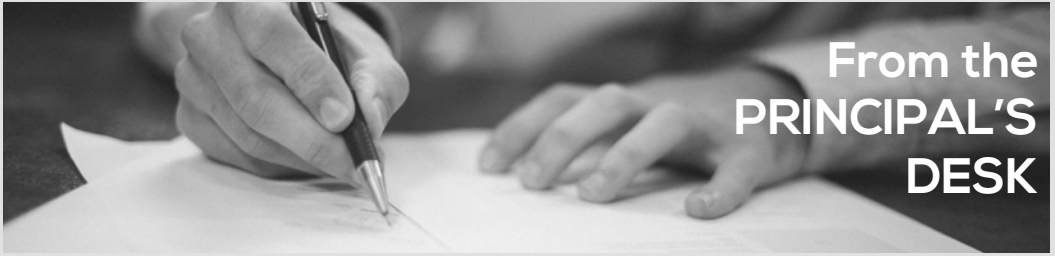

These developments are crucial for enhancing our students' learning environment and overall school experience. 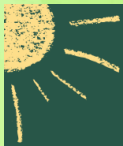
Our tennis season has started for the Primary School this week. We have entered 2 teams: u11 and u13

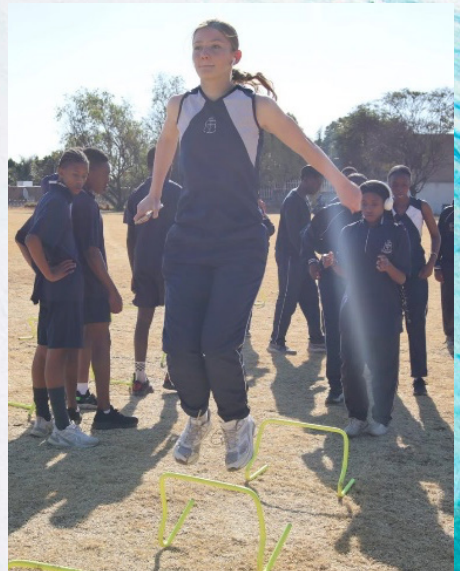
